ABOUT ISURAVA

Kokoda Youth Foundation's Isurava Program is a transformative 12-month youth program that promotes positive change in young people. It aims to support at-risk youth aged 8–17, by helping prevent anti-social behaviour and youth justice involvement.

Throughout the program, participants increase their resilience, re-engage with education, and achieve personal growth. They take part in adventure-based camps, one-on-one mentoring, community service, and ongoing aftercare support.

PROGRAM GOALS



ENHANCE EDUCATIONAL ENGAGEMENT

Fostering a more positive attitude towards school and education.



DEVELOP ESSENTIAL LIFE SKILLS

Building teamwork, resilience and leadership skills.



IMPROVE BEHAVIOURAL OUTCOMES

Changing behavioural patterns for positive outcomes.



CULTIVATE CIVIC RESPONSIBILITY

Developing a service-mindset and greater social responsibility.

CORE PHASES

- ✓ Detailed assessment and goal-setting
- ✓ 7-day residential Foundation Camp with challenge-based activities
- ✓ 10-week intensive mentoring phase
- ✓ 5-day wilderness growth camp
- ✓ 10-week transition period with weekly mentoring and community service
- ✓ 4-day 'Peak Experience' expedition
- ✓ 6 months of ongoing aftercare support
